Please read all information below as it relates to the Antiques Division for Apple Blossom 2019:

Event Date: Friday, May 3, 2019

Judging/Line Up: Red Bud Run Elementary School (Millbrook High School)

The following times, rules and procedures will be strictly adhered to:

- **The absolute deadline for applications is Friday, April 19th.** Applications received after this date will cause the unit to be placed at the end of the lineup, no media information will be provided to the parade announcers, **and unit will NOT BE JUDGED.**
- All registered units must be at least 25 years of age and must be fire or rescue related vehicles. There will be no exception to this rule.
- A separate application and insurance statement is required for each unit.
- **All units must stop at the Check In site to be marked as attending and to receive a registration packet containing essential information for the day's events. Units to be judged are to proceed directly to the front of the elementary school - no exceptions.**
- **Judging will begin promptly at 10:30 and end at 1:30. No units will be judged after 1:30.** Winners will be *announced and* trophies awarded at the Driver's Meeting.
- The **MANDATORY DRIVER'S MEETING WILL TAKE PLACE AT 3:00 pm** in front of the Red Bud Run Elementary school. All drivers must attend this meeting. Failure to attend will result in the elimination of your apparatus from the parade and denial of any potential awards.
- Safety Officers will check each unit for: operable fire extinguisher; wheel chocks; and a basic first aid kit.
